Septic Systems

All cottages/businesses are required to have a septic system that meets or exceeds the standards set out in the Ontario Building Code (OBC) and by the Saugeen First Nation. The minimum system in the ground must be a 800 gal. tank and bed or 2000 gal holding tank. Any system that does not meet these standards will be required to upgrade immediately. All leased lots will be required to show proof of a compliant system prior to any lease renewal in 2021.

Sauble Park

Due to the high water levels of Lake Huron in 2020, the Sauble Park will not open for the summer but regular maintenance will continue.

Lake Huron High Water Levels

Over the past 2 years we have seen the water levels in Lake Huron rise to almost record levels which has caused a variety of issues along the shoreline. Updates on the water levels can be seen on the Lake Huron Coastal Conservation website.

Emerald Ash Borer (Invasive Species)

The emerald ash borer (EAB) is a highly destructive invasive beetle which attacks and kills all species of ash trees and is confirmed in the Saugeen territory. Although not every local population of ash trees in Saugeen are showing signs of the beetle infestation, owners are encouraged to keep a close eye on the ash tree within their leased lots. If you suspect an ash tree(s) on your lot has the invasive species and is showing signs of overall poor health such as flaking bark, thinning crown and epicormic branching. Contact the Lands office to discuss options immediately.

Landfill Site Passes

Landfill passes will be issued on payment of Service Fees at the Lands Management Office or mailed out along with your receipt.

Contractors hired by lessees must produce a "Letter of Approval" for construction issued by the Lands Office to enter the landfill site. However, this only permits Landfill Site access and all applicable fees for disposal still apply.

Additional Rates (Landfill Site)

Cartons/Boxes of garbage - \$4.00 each

Trailer of garbage - \$100.00

Pick up truck of garbage - \$50.00

Bagged garbage - \$3.00 each

Shingles - \$100.00 per tonne

Furniture - \$30.00 (at discretion of monitor)

Appliances - \$40.00 (at discretion of monitor)

Blue Boxes - \$8.00 (available at Works Dept).

Tires will not be collected due to disposal costs per tire, but tires will be accepted at the landfill site for a small fee. If you have large appliances, please call the Works Department at (519)797-3934, 519-797-1057

Additional Notes

- All additional bags of garbage that exceed the 2 per week limit must have SFN bag tags attached to be picked up!
- There will be no additional garbage pickups for those who miss the scheduled time.
- Any vehicles parked on the road(s) restricting Grading or Plowing will be towed.
- All Build/Septic projects require permits, approvals and payment prior to any work commencing.
