Dear SCOI members,

Saugeen First Nation (SFN) is holding a new vote on July 14, 2021 to address the next 5-year lease for the specific 87 band owned lots. Furthermore, SFN will be issuing temporary permits for a 2-year period to cover the temporary gap in lease.

The following is a briefing and clarification of SFN's next steps. To do this, we have highlighted a few topics based on questions we have heard from your members, with a brief clarification for each topic:

87 band owned lots:

These are 87 lots which are band owned lots requiring a "Designation Vote" by SFN membership.

Renewal of 5-year lease agreements:

An affirmative New Vote outcome on July 14, 2021 will see these 87 band owned lots having their corresponding 5-year lease agreements ready for signing by September 2021. Once the new lease is issued, the previously issued temporary 2-year period permits will become null and void.

Service fee payments will remain normal:

Regardless of the New Vote outcome, all 87 band owned lots will still be able to enjoy the use of their cottage this summer under the temporarily issued 2-year permits or the longer 5-year lease.

Finally, I would like to thank SCOI members ahead of time, for all your patience and understanding regarding this New Vote process.
